## 2003 RED WINE, PASO ROBLES

Martin & Weyrich is known as the pioneer of Cal-Ital wines in the United States. Insieme is part of this tradition; a New World blend of Old World grapes grown in California.

Insieme translates to “together,” in Italian and “seamless” in the Piedmontese dialect, and was our choice for a name, as this wine combines Italian with French varieties.

Northern Italy is represented by the noble Barbera and Nebbiolo and Central Italy by the versatile Sangiovese. Petit Verdot is the only French variety along with a small amount of Zinfandel to further round out this exquisite blend.

2003 Insieme is a rich, full-bodied wine, perfect with tomato-based pasta dishes, roasted pasta dishes, roasted fowl and red meats.
