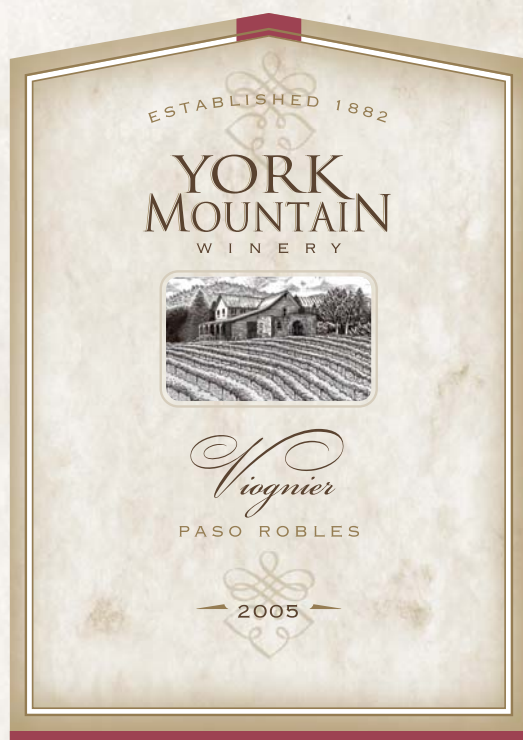

York Mountain Winery was founded in 1882 on California's Central Coast, by Andrew York who tended the vines along with his sons and grandsons. Almost 125 years later, it is now the oldest local winery in continuous operation, still family run, now by Mary and David Weyrich and their children.

Originating in the warm northern Rhone region of France, Viognier has become one of the world's most popular white wines in the past decade. York Mountain's Viognier is produced from our Weyrich Family Ranch in Paso Robles, which is now considered one of the best areas in California to grow this highly prized white wine grape.

Our Viognier is rich and complex with aromas of peaches, apricots and honeysuckle, along with a lingering spicy finish. Its bold flavors will match well with Asian, Cajun or Indian cuisine. We love it with sushi.
